CAMP OMEGA PLUNGE The Youth Group participated in the Camp Omega Plunge at Morristown Community Center. Their team name was “Freezin’ For A Reason” and they raised over \$3,600. The event in total raised \$33,285 for the new family center at Camp Omega, with a total of 103 participants! This year new records were set as well - with two teams raising over \$7,000, nine teams raising \$2,000-\$3,000, nine new teams participating, and 60 new plungers!
