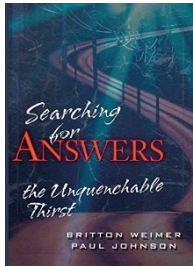
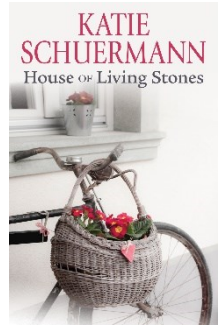


### **SUMMER WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY**

### **MISSIONS' HANGING PLANT SALE**

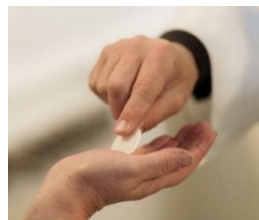
