

Please contact Michael Hentges for more information. **THE LUTHER HOUSE IN ROCHESTER** The former parsonage of Trinity Lutheran Church, Rochester has been converted into The Luther House. This facility consists of 3 units that will provide a comfortable and free place to stay for LCMS members in need who are seeking medical treatment at the Mayo Clinic. All units will share a main entry and laundry, but will have private doors/locked entrances.

The Luther House consists of:

- A one-bedroom efficiency unit with kitchenette and 3/4 bathroom
- A one-bedroom unit with full kitchen and full bathroom, sitting area with gas log fireplace, and outdoor sitting area
- A two-bedroom unit with full kitchen, spacious living room, and full bathroom

You are cordially invited to an Open House on Saturday, July 23 from 4-6 pm and on Sunday, July 31 from 9 am - 12 pm. Come and see how God is working in Rochester to



provide help and shelter to Lutherans in need. This new facility is replacing the TLCare Apartments that helped Lutherans in need for about 10 years.
