MEN’S TUESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY is taking a break for the summer. We will resume on September 13th.

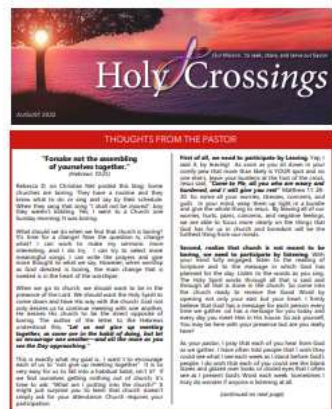
