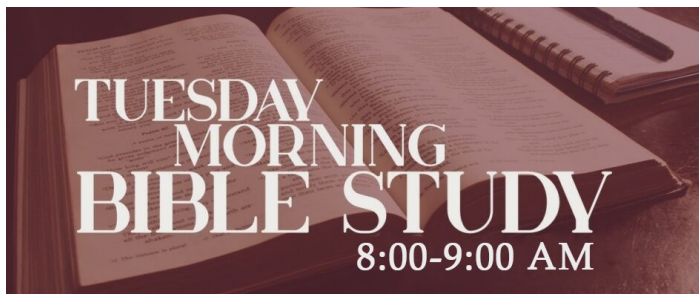
WOMEN’S ONE NIGHT BIBLE STUDY
