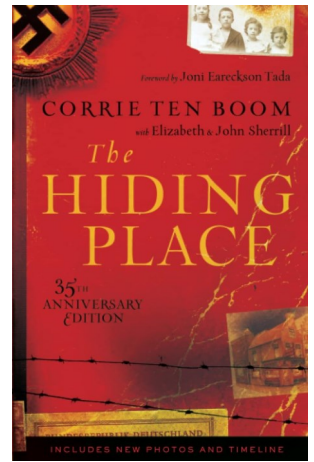

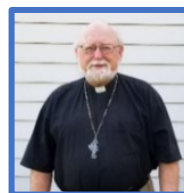
### THE INFORMATION CENTER
