


DID YOU KNOW...

Thank you For not judging people, and always embracing everyone with open arms.




LWML MITE BOXES Over the years, many Lutheran Women in Mission groups used a box to gather funds in support of local and synod ministries. Instead of "mite boxes" some groups called their ingathering devices "blessing boxes" or "mission boxes" or "thank offering boxes."

Mite boxes have changed in color and design over the years, but what has never changed is the dedication of freely given offerings for the purpose of reaching out to others with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Based on the Biblical account of the widow's mite, the Mite Box is intended for regular contributions of "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to the congregation and the Synod. Mite Box contributions amount to millions of dollars that fund district and national mission grants. In fact, over \$100 million dollars has been collected since 1942. Yes ... these coins have and will continue to make a difference. Thank you for contributing to the Mite Box and providing the opportunity for us to spread the Gospel to the world.

Today you'll find a large Mite Box in the back of church; drop your coins/mites in the box and join us in making a difference and spreading the Gospel around the world. The box will be out all month for your donations. Grab a small Mite Box for your home or office and collect your mite offerings all year long.
