TUESDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY is at 8:00 am here at the church. Join us if you are free. No homework or things to prepare, just bring your Bible.

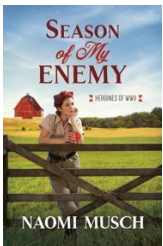
ATTENTION BIBLE BOOKENDERS

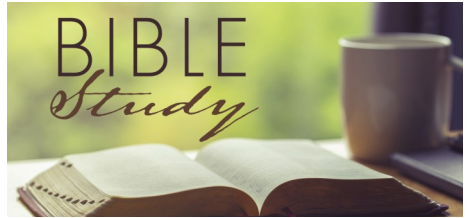

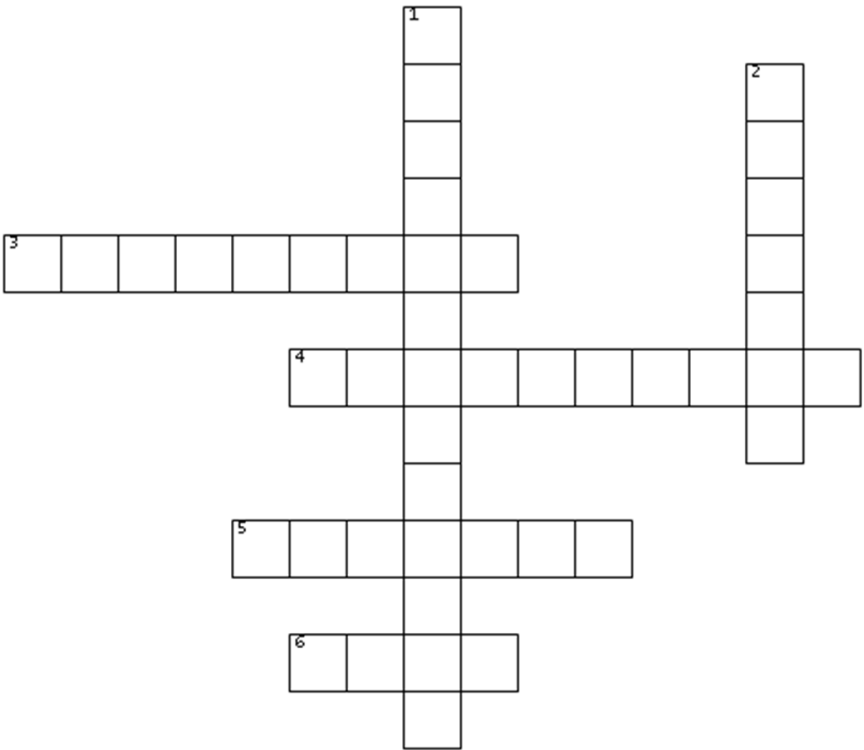
